



Dr Matthias Janssen is a Manager in Frontier's Cologne office

He specialises in electricity and gas markets and is an economic expert on market design, trading issues and market modelling.

He has worked on various projects in the German and European gas market, including for FNB Gas on the role of the gas infrastructure in 2050, and for GGI and Net4Gas looking more widely on the role of gas infrastructure in several European countries. He also supports the European Commission to identify regulatory gaps and barriers for sector coupling technologies such as power-to-hydrogen. Recently, he worked for a consortium that analyses to invest in facilities to produce hydrogen from offshore wind in the North Sea.

Matthias regularly works for clients in Switzerland, particularly for the Swiss Federal Office for Energy (BFE) on various energy-related questions such as electricity market design or unbundling of network operators.

Before joining Frontier Economics in 2011, Matthias worked as a researcher at the Department of Economic Theory in Muenster, Germany, for four years, where he focussed on electricity and gas pricing in liberalized energy markets.
